



CLASS OF '66 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Scottsbluff High School Band Student graduating senior

Applications will be reviewed annually for the Class of '66 Memorial Scholarship. A \$1,000 scholarship will be given annually to a Scottsbluff High School graduating senior who is an **outstanding band student**. Application forms are available at the Scottsbluff High School Counseling Office or from the band director.

Deadline for application and supporting documents is April 1st. Recipients will be announced in May.

To qualify for the Class of '66 Memorial Scholarship, students must:

- Be enrolled full-time at an accredited college, university or vocational or technical school
- Carry a minimum of 12 hours

Recipients are responsible for forwarding college transcripts to OTCF within three (3) weeks of the end of each grading period and must notify OTCF of any address changes. Failure to send transcripts jeopardizes scholarship renewal. Scholarships are paid directly to the school. If the required college GPA is not maintained, or the student is not enrolled full-time (beginning the first semester for which the scholarship is awarded), the renewal opportunity will be forfeited. The scholarship may be rescinded and awarded to the alternate.
